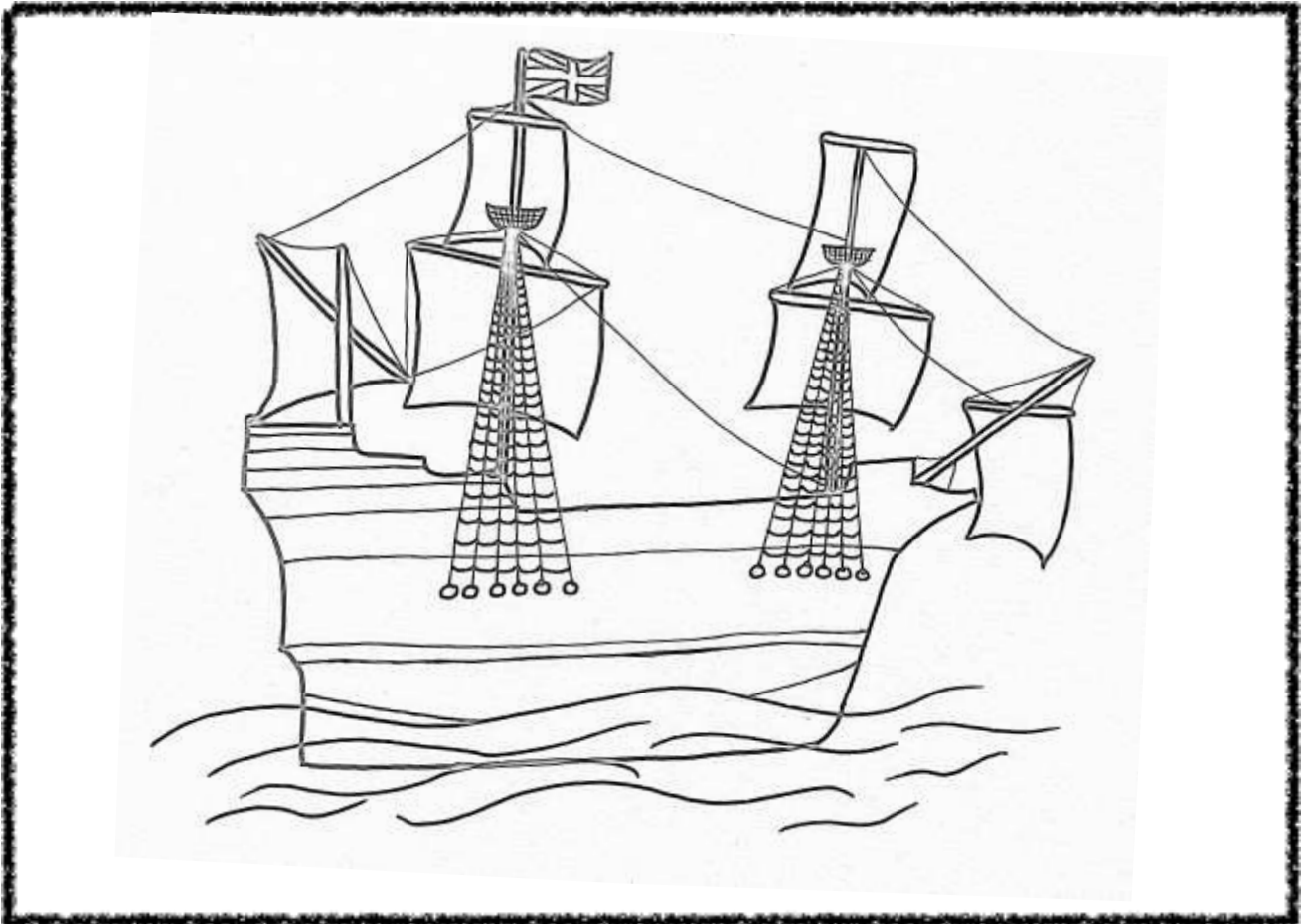

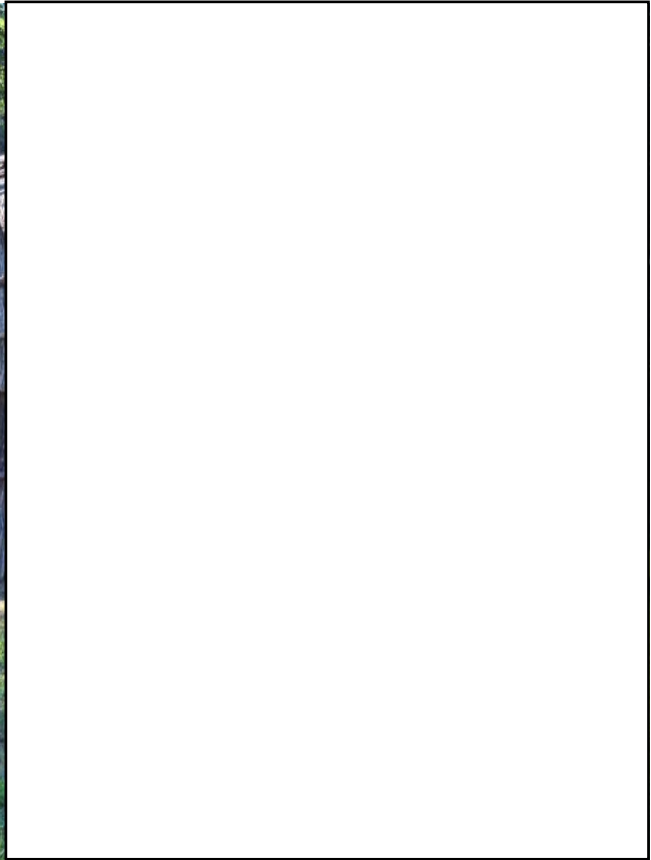

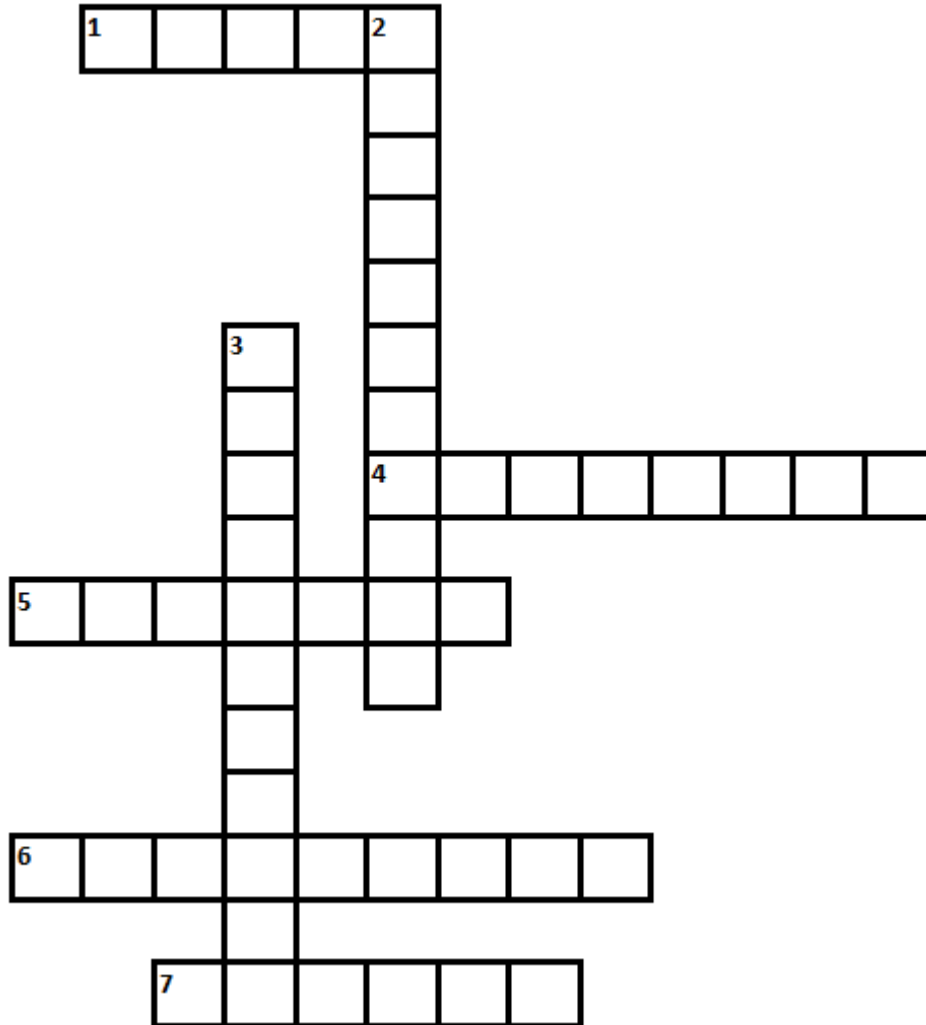
Complete the Drawing

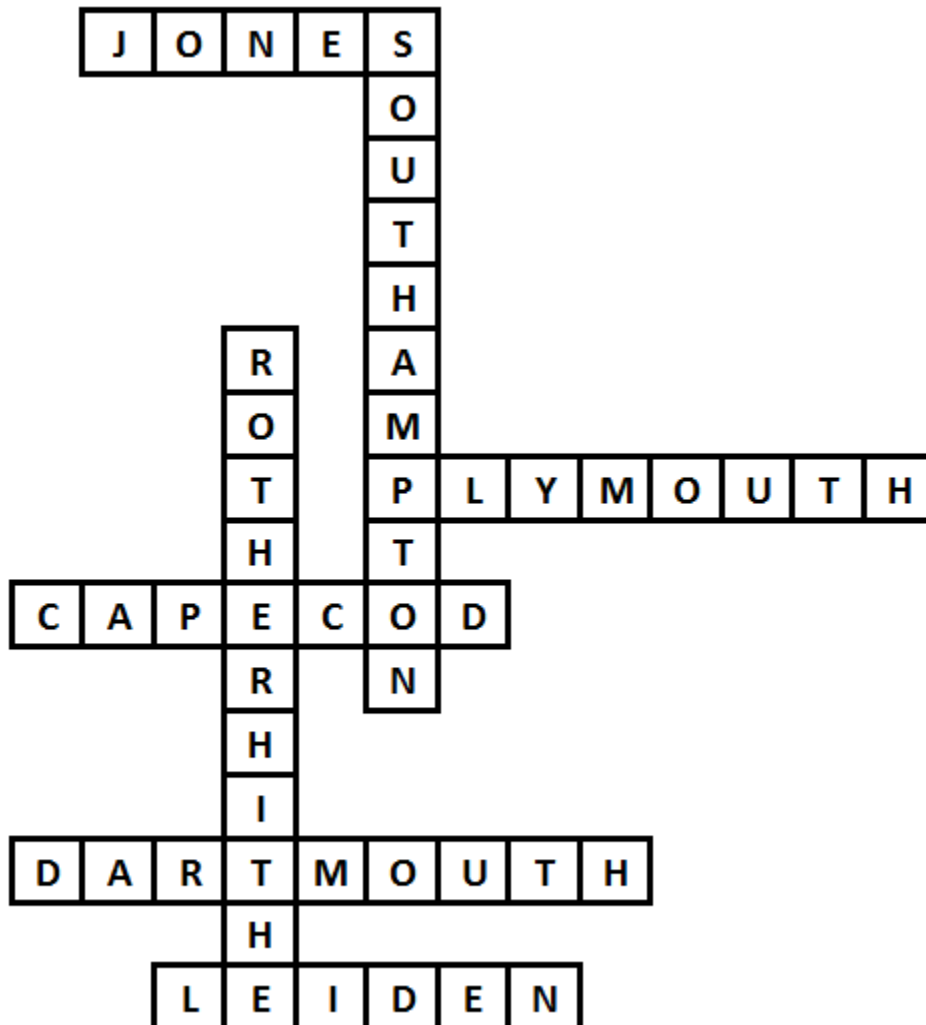
